**SUBJECT:** Warfel honored by Associated Builders and Contractors Keystone Chapter

Warfel Construction Company recently received **five** awards from the Keystone Chapter of the Associated Builders and Contractors at Annual Excellence in Construction Awards dinner. The event recognizes contractors who perform work throughout central PA and the surrounding areas.



Warfel received a first place Award of Excellence in the Restoration/Renovation category for the historic **St. Andrew's Episcopal Church** in Glenmoore, PA. The church, virtually untouched since it was originally constructed in 1833, was expanded and renovated by Warfel. The \$1.2 million project included a new addition, matching the historical façade and interior finishes of the existing building, as well as upgrading the systems throughout. Warfel also received an Award of Excellence in the Institutional Category for the Renovation and Expansion of the **Berman Museum of Art at Ursinus College** in Collegeville, PA. This \$3.9 million project included the construction of a 4,200 sf wing featuring a magnificent curved



glass atrium housing a formal exhibition gallery and education spaces for the Museum's permanent collection.

Warfel also received three additional Awards of Merit for the following projects; the new \$2.6 million **Penn Cinema IMAX** in Lititz, PA, the \$6 million **Frank Theatres** 13 screen cinema at the Queensgate Towne Center in York, PA, and the \$1 million **Moore's Memorial Library Renovation** in Christiana, PA.
