SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company Awarded \$4 million renovation project

East Petersburg, PA – Warfel Construction Company was recently awarded a \$4 million contract to expand and renovate the Philip and Muriel Berman Museum of Art at Ursinus College. The new 4200 sq. ft. Henry and June Pfeiffer Wing will feature a unique open storage area for the study and exhibition of the Museum’s permanent collection. The addition will also provide area for storage, lecture space, and new galleries including a rooftop gallery for outdoor sculpture. Minor interior renovations will also be completed. The historic stone building was originally constructed in 1921 as the Alumni Memorial Library. Warfel began work on this 10 month project in June.

Overseeing the project for Warfel is Project Manager Brett Calabretta and Field Superintendent Dave Marks, both of Lancaster. The project is designed by Philadelphia firm Towers & Miller Architects.
