SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company awarded \$4.4 million school contract

East Petersburg, PA, May 25, 2010 – Warfel Construction Company was recently awarded a \$4.4 million dollar contract from the Penn Manor School District to renovate the existing Central Manor Elementary School. The project will include approximately 60,000 sq. ft. of renovations and the addition of two new classroom wings totaling 11,000 sq. ft. The project is anticipated to achieve LEED Gold level certification. Part of this effort will be the installation of a geothermal heating system and a LEED resource display in the hallway for the children to learn about LEED building practices.

Overseeing the project for Warfel is Project Manager Brett Calabretta, and Superintendent Phil Geyer, both of Lancaster. The project, designed by Crabtree, Rohrbaugh & Associates Architects, of Mechanicsburg, is scheduled for completion in November 2011.
