SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company awarded over \$11 million in school contracts

East Petersburg, PA, October 21, 2010 – Warfel Construction Company was recently awarded the general trades contracts for projects in the Lower Dauphin School District and the Elizabethtown Area School District.

Encompassing a total of 80,000 sq. ft, the \$5.5 million project at Conewago Elementary in the Lower Dauphin School District includes a two-story classroom wing addition and a single story wing including offices, a kitchen, and a multipurpose room that will serve as the cafeteria and gymnasium. A portion of the existing building will be demolished to create a new parking area, while the remaining building will be renovated to create a media room and additional classrooms. The project is anticipated to achieve LEED Silver certification and features 70 geo-thermal wells and a wind energy conversion system. Overseeing the project for Warfel is Senior Project Manager Fred Lohss, and Superintendent Jeff Rosengrant, both of Lancaster. The project is designed by EI Associates Architects, of Harrisburg.

In the Elizabethtown Area School District, the \$4.9 million East High Elementary School project features 70,000 sq. ft. of new construction and renovation work. The two-story expansion includes a gymnasium, classrooms, and storage spaces while renovation work will be completed in the library, cafeteria, multi-purpose room, offices and existing classrooms. The 17 month project is designed by Crabtree Rohrbaugh & Associates of Mechanicsburg and will be overseen by Project Manager Brett Calabretta and Field Superintendent, Brian Musser, both of Lancaster.
