SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company awarded Manheim Twp. School project

East Petersburg, PA, January 20, 2011 – Warfel Construction Company was recently awarded the \$17.4 million general trades contract for the new Manheim Township School District Landis Run Intermediate School. The 207,000 sq. ft. school will house the districts fifth and sixth grade students. The building consists of two 3-story classroom wings housing 48 classrooms, labs, small group instruction classrooms, a media center, art and music rooms, a gymnasium that serves as an auditorium with a stage, and a cafeteria seating 400 students. Seeking LEED Silver certification, the building will feature ‘green’ elements such as recycled materials, sun tubes to maximize the natural light throughout the facility, and water efficient fixtures to reduce water consumption by an estimated 40%.

Overseeing the project for Warfel is Project Manager Brett Calabretta, LEED AP and Superintendent John Hess, both of Lancaster. Designed by Crabtree Rohrbaugh & Associates of Mechanicsburg, the 20 month project will be completed in August 2012.
